Pastor Sharon's Note

Peggy Sue Wells and Pat Palau wrote in *What to Do When You Don't Want to Go to Church* (page 107), "As a busy, driven person I have to be accomplishing and producing something all the time. I thrive on being effective and efficient. My childhood church was mired in the ruts of old habits, unchanging leadership, and repetitive themes. It was boring and as soon as I was old enough to make my own decisions, I stopped attending.

"In college I followed my heart's conviction that I should return to church and began attending a large congregation that boasted an active college ministry. I surrendered my life to Jesus and began seeking the Lord for myself rather than expecting to be spoon-fed from the pulpit. The first turning point was realizing that not all churches are stodgy. Some move and grow and adapt to changing times and changing audiences. Second, I have a responsibility to God to be an active contributing part of a healthy fellowship. Church is not a passive activity. Church is a participatory event where I am involved with other believers. It's about me making a sacrifice of time and energy, giving insights and encouragement to other believers. Church is about reaching out to others with the comfort I have received. It is more about giving than receiving."

Wells and Palau could be writing about any of us. Church attendance is really about what we ourselves invest in our community of faith. If we are dissatisfied, then it is up to us to help seek change rather than simply running away from the source of the dissatisfaction. Running away only allows the problem to continue. (So does criticizing those whom we believe to be the source of the problem without seeking to be a part of the solution. Becoming part of the solution means offering solutions for solving the problem which are creative and positive. And then actively working to implement changes.) A responsible faith becomes an active part of the solution. Being part of the solution requires commitment, time, and energy.
